Significantly Reduces Violence and Builds Relationships

Problem:

In 2008, the staff at Deborah Tennant-Zinewicz School (DTZ) in Norwich, Conn. embarked on a mission to substantially improve the quality of the educational experience offered at the school. The number of suspensions and calls to the police had become a significant concern. Staff and students were in need of a common language to facilitate problem-solving.

Solution:

DTZ staff was trained by PeaceBuilders professionals to work with students to reduce aggressive and violent behavior and create a more peaceful, productive environment. Fortified with new curriculum and strategies, teachers set clear expectations for student conduct and reinforced desired behaviors and achievements with praise, encouragement and acknowledgement.

Results:

PeaceBuilders helped reduce violence through an active, structured process that builds a sense of community and commitment to non-violent, sustainable relationships. Principal Woody Crowley says that PeaceBuilders is helping achieve measurable, sustained improvements in student behavior at DTZ by providing a clear, easily understood language that staff and students can effectively utilize when addressing conflicts and struggles within the school community. In addition to the students attending DTZ school, beneficiaries of the PeaceBuilders program include the families, the staff, and the students' home communities.
